## RULES AND GUIDELINES

**The AfterSchool Program follows the same standards of behavior, respect, and rules as the regular school day.**

(Details can be found in the Student Handbook.)

OUR BASIC DAILY RULES AND GUIDELINES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

***Each Person Has The Right To Be Respected***

(No kicking, hitting, or hurting each other. Students will respect the adults on duty; they will not use inappropriate language)

***Each Person Has The Right To Have His Or Her Personal Property Respected***

***Each Person Will Respect School Property And Boundaries***

***Each Person Has The Right To Feel Safe And Comfortable***

(Unkind teasing and bullying will not be tolerated)

OTHER GUIDELINES:

- Do homework when asked
- Use the Homework Card to show completion of work
- No non-school work or computers during Homework Club time
- Sign in and out when leaving each room
- Students will not wander around the school
- Report to the AfterSchool Program immediately once school is dismissed for the day

Students who do not follow these rules and guidelines shall be subject to the consequences as outlined in the Behavior Agreement.
